## Primary, Urgent or Emergency Care

### Primary Care

Prevention, diagnosis and treatment for conditions at any stage of life

MercyOne is urging people with COVID-19 symptoms to contact your provider office to assess any active symptoms over the phone or determine if a telehealth appointment is available for you.

### Urgent Care

Treatment for non-life threatening health concerns requiring urgent medical attention

Before going to an urgent care for COVID-related visits, contact your primary care provider.

### Emergency Care

Treatment for serious injury or severe illnesses that may require hospitalization

Before going to an emergency department for COVID-related visits, contact your primary care provider.

If you are experiencing only mild COVID-related symptoms, please do not visit the emergency department to be tested.

## Testing for COVID-19

#### MODERATE SYMPTOMS

If you feel sick with fever, cough or difficulty breathing, contact your health care provider. Don't have a provider? Find one near you. Many of our providers offer telehealth visits.

#### MILD OR NO SYMPTOMS

Order or pick up an at-home kit. If you test positive, let your primary care provider know so that they can discuss appropriate care and treatment options.
