### Military and Veterans Health Care at MercyOne

Military and Veterans Health Care helps MercyOne colleagues better understand the physical, emotional and spiritual impact of operational deployments on service members and their families. With this enhanced awareness of patients' military experience, MercyOne positions itself to provide a more comprehensive health care experience for its military service members, veterans and their families.

### **Expanded Obstetrics and Gynecology Care**

MercyOne Cedar Falls OB/GYN, a new 5,500-square foot addition to MercyOne Bluebell Road Health Plaza includes nine exam rooms, a procedure room, ultrasound room and multiple nursing stations for mothers.

#### **MercyOne Oelwein Medical Center**

MercyOne Oelwein Medical Center has been active with Community Care financial support for eligible patients, free Care-A-Van transportation for MercyOne patients to their appointments, and a partnership with the Northeast Iowa Food Bank to host a monthly mobile food pantry which serves nearly 200 households each month.

#### **Medication Access Coordinator**

Certified pharmacy technicians assist patients in obtaining their specialty medications. They handle the process from starting prior authorizations to ensuring medication is delivered when needed. These technicians also help families locate funding to drastically reduce the patient's co-pay cost, sometimes down to \$0.
