Fentanyl and Methadone Added to Urine Drug Screen

Effective July 6, 2022 MercyOne Des Moines Laboratory and MercyOne West Des Moines Laboratory will add qualitative Fentanyl (cutoff: 1.0 ng/mL) and Methadone (cutoff: 300 ng/mL) testing to all urine drug screens. Collection requirements, stability, CPT codes and pricing will remain the same. Reflex confirmatory testing for detected drugs will be billed separately.
