	Provide <u>three</u> forms of recommendation using the MercyOne Clinton Scholarship Reference Form.
	Incomplete applications are subject to disqualification

Selection of scholarship recipients will <u>not</u> be based on sex, age, race, color, national origin, disability, marital status or religion.

She started her exceptional career at Jane Lamb in Clinton on the medical floor in 1986 and continued on the medical/surgical floor at Mercy Medical Center when the two hospitals merged. Kathy's love for her patients brought her to the Radiation/Oncology department in early 2015 where her gift for compassionate patient care was prominent until her death from cancer in January 2016.

Even through Kathy's illness, she continued to work until she was no longer able, putting her patients' needs above her own. Many patients remember Kathy for her bright smile and how she consistently went above and beyond for not only the needs of her patients, but their families as well. Because of this, Kathy received the Daisy Award for Extraordinary Nurses in 2012. Before her death, Kathy wanted to make sure that others were given the opportunity to excel in the healthcare field like she did.
