The Stryker 1788 4K Platform with Advanced

Imaging Modality Video System will bring enhanced technology to the operating rooms. The 1788 Platform is Stryker's latest endoscopic camera systems, most sophisticated, and comprehensive advancement for surgical visualization for multiple surgical specialties including orthopedics, general/gynecology surgery, ear, nose, and throat (ENT), podiatry, and urology. The use of this upgraded platform will impact 7,500 surgical cases at MercyOne Cedar



Falls Medical Center and MercyOne Waterloo Medical Center on an average per year.

- Images will significantly improve from our current platform of the 1488 to the 1788 camera. With the newest 7th generation platform, updates were made to hardware/software to improve light-balancing and enhancements to the fluorescence imaging capabilities, giving a more vibrant picture.
- SPY technology (fluorescence imaging) is built into the camera to give surgeons the ability to see beyond the standard wavelength of white light. This will allow identification of critical anatomy, prevent surgical complications, and improve operating room efficiency for both open and minimally invasive procedures.
- The total investment for both medical centers is \$3,267,813. This includes a video upgrade for three rooms and one mobile tower in Cedar Falls, and eight rooms and two mobile towers in Waterloo.
